Research Analysis

The third proposed committee substitute for HB1379 modifies numerous provisions governing tax increment financing (TIF) district by:

- requiring voter approval from every taxing jurisdiction included in proposed district to create a TIF district. Current law only requires a majority vote of the governing body to approve the TIF;
- eliminating the ability for a TIF review committee to hold executive sessions and withhold confidential information;
- deleting references to blighted areas from the Local Development Act;
- prohibiting the TIF review committee members from receiving things of value from any person or entity that would benefit from the TIF;
- requiring the review committee to meet at least once every year; and
- requiring the review committee to complete the following prior to voting to recommend a TIF:
 - o complete 12 hours of educational instruction on the Local Development Act;
 - o hear presentations from supporter and opponents of the TIF;
 - o review information on the business structure, governance policies and formation details of every for profit entity that would benefit from the TIF; and
 - o conduct an economic impact study on the proposed project.
