Research Analysis

HB 1385, as introduced, requires that applications for chiropractic continuing education seminars be submitted to and reviewed by the Board of Chiropractic Examiners. The Board may authorize their Executive Director to temporarily approve applications, or amendments to an application. The measure also removes the 90 day time frame requirement for submitting applications to the Board, and the 60 day time frame requirement for the Board to issue a ruling on the application.
