Fiscal Analysis

HB1393, as introduced, moves fees covering the cost of transportation escorts from Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT) to the Department of Public Safety (DPS). As DPS incurs the cost of the transport, moving payment to DPS should not create a fiscal impact for either agency. Therefore, there is no impact to state appropriations.
