## **Research Analysis**

The committee substitute for HB 1397 requires the State Department of Education to develop a curriculum about the civil rights movement from 1954 to 1968, the natural law and natural rights principles, and the tactics of non-violent resistance employed by Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. The course may be taught as a stand-alone unit, or integrated into pre-existing course work. There shall be an additional unit of instruction studying other acts of discriminatory injustice, such as genocide, committed elsewhere around the globe.
