**Research Analysis**

HB 1397, as introduced, requires public elementary schools and high schools to include in their curriculum a unit of instruction about the civil rights movement from 1954 to 1968, and a unit of instruction studying other acts of discriminatory injustice, including information about the Holocaust, the Armenian genocide, the Uyghurs in China, and the Rohingya of Burma.

The State Superintendent is required to prepare and make such instructional materials available to public schools.
