Research Analysis

HB 1404 removes the prohibition on the transport of firearms in a vessel or boat and clarifies that it is only unlawful to discharge a firearm except in cases of self-defense, hinting animals or fowl. The measure increases the punishment for violations from \$50 to not more than \$100 and lowers the possibility of jail time from six months to three months. The measure also removes language relating to persons in possession of a valid handgun license.
