Research Analysis

HB 1408 requires first responders and volunteer first responders, who are subject to drug testing, to verbally report any potential passive exposure to a controlled dangerous drug that occurred while responding to an emergency within the previous 14 days. Responders are to verbally report to their agency or employer prior to testing. Documentation regarding the verbal report is to be provided to the medical review officer in the event of a positive drug test.
