Research Analysis

The committee substitute for HB 1420 replaces the words "cow" and "goat" within the Oklahoma Milk and Milk Products Act with the phrase "hooved mammals". Further the measure requires the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture to cooperate with the United States Department of Health and Human Services, United States Public Health Service, and United States Food and Drug Administration for dairy inspection and grading.
