Research Analysis

HB 1596, as introduced, establishes a petty cash fund for the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement (ABLE) Commission. The purpose of which is to be used for supplying its agents with money for undercover operations to obtain critical evidence for case presentations. The fund shall not exceed \$5,000. The measure allows for the fund to be reimbursed from time to time by the filing of proper claims, accompanied by valid receipts for expenditures made. The ABLE Commission will be authorized to prescribe forms, systems, and procedures for the administration of the fund.
