Research Analysis

HB 1650, as introduced, extends the expiration date for minimum rates of reimbursement by an additional 5 years from July 1, 2026 to until July 1, 2031. The measure adds that anesthesia will continue to be reimbursed equal to or greater than the anesthesia fee schedule established by the Authority as of January 1, 2021. The measure also allows for anesthesia providers to enter into value based payment arrangements for services furnished to enrollees of the state Medicaid program.
