**Research Analysis**

HB 1711, as introduced, requires every existing licensed medical marijuana commercial grower to inform retail suppliers or electric cooperatives utilized of their status as a licensed medical marijuana commercial grower within 30 days. All new licensees must inform the retail supplier or electric cooperative at the time of connection of services. The measure also requires commercial growers to electronically transmit monthly reports to the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority providing the amount of electricity and water consumed. Refusal or failure to submit the required monthly usage reports or use of an unpermitted water source by a commercial grower will result in the permanent revocation of their license.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 1711 states that every existing licensed medical marijuana commercial grower to notify the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority within 30 days of electricity and water usage. New licensee will provide that to OMMA at the time of connection. Per the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority is cost is estimated be \$10,000 to modify their existing platform to accept reporting.
