The CS to HB 1737 provides that after an innkeeper informs a person that he or she is being ejected, the person is to be considered a trespasser and not a guest of the lodging establishment. If the person fails to leave the establishment, the person is to be removed from the lodging establishment by law enforcement for trespassing.
