Research Analysis

The CS to HB 1762 provides that a person previously convicted of domestic abuse who is subsequently convicted of the unlawful carry of a firearm is guilty of a felony punishable by not less than 1 year nor more than 5 years in prison, a fine of not less than \$1,000 nor more than \$5,000 or both fine and imprisonment.
