Research Analysis

The Conference Committee Substitute B to HB 1792 creates the Oklahoma Sentencing Modernization Act of 2024. The measure creates classifications for each criminal felony offense found in statute into a classification system of 15 different categories and establishes maximum and minimum amounts of time to be served for each category. The measure provides that minimum time-served requires may be included in the instructions to the jury during a criminal trial. The measure exempts certain crimes from the penalty provisions found in the classification system.

Fiscal Analysis

This measure creates new law which establishes a classification for all felony criminal offenses provided for in the Oklahoma Statutes and sets forth maximum fines for each classification. After consultation with officials from the Administrative Office of the Courts, it is not anticipated that HB1792 will have an impact on state budget or appropriations.

The CCR B to the measure does not create fiscal impact.
