Research Analysis

The conference committee report for HB 1795 accepts Senate Amendments No. 2 and 3 and restores the title.

HB1795, as amended, creates the Sergeant CJ Nelson Legacy Act. The measure allows children of police officers, emergency medical technicians, and firefighters who have died in the line of duty not to be charged fees or room and board at any state college or university. The waiver is limited to five years.
