Research Analysis

The Senate amendments to HB 1795 strike the enacting clause and require that the waiver of fees, in addition to room and board, is limited to five years.

HB 1795, as amended, creates the Sergeant CJ Nelson Legacy Act. The measure allows children of police officers, emergency medical technicians, and firefighters who have died in the line of duty not to be charged fees or room and board at any state college or university. The waiver is limited to five years.

Fiscal Analysis

The long-term fiscal impact will be contingent upon how many students are eligible for the benefit and will utilize it. Based upon the available data on fallen first responders, it is anticipated that this may apply to 10-15 individuals on an annual basis. Below is a breakdown of the averages of mandatory costs associated with each of the three tiers of Oklahoma's higher education institutions.
