Research Analysis

HB 1882, as introduced, modifies the state school accountability system. The measure:

- Prohibits the accountability system from assigning letter grades to schools and school districts based on test scores;
- Requires the system to use school climate as one of its measures of accountability; and
- Removes chronic absenteeism as a measure of accountability.
