Research Analysis

HB 1938, as introduced, requires school boards to accept credits and grades for courses completed by a student at another school, and requires school boards to adopt policies for the acceptance and reciprocity of such credits and grades. The policy may set reasonable timelines and may require adequate and timely documentation for establishing authenticity of credits and grades.

Further, the policy must provide various methods for earning credit for coursework completed at a non-accredited educational provider. If the board denies credit or grades from a non-accredited source, the board must notify the student in writing within 10 days. The student or guardian may appeal to the State Board of Education.
