## **Fiscal Analysis**

HB 1967 in its current form authorizes county options related to the implementation of an additional 1% sales tax for the purpose of supporting emergency medical services. The measure permits counties to choose implement such a tax, the measure does not mandate any county action. The measure does not authorize the collection of state revenues as a result of the additional county levy. For these reasons the measure is not anticipated to have a direct impact on the state budget or appropriations.
