**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute for HB 2007 allows a school superintendent to designate an employee to transport stolen, dangerous or illegal items found on a student after a search. The items must be transported to a centralized location on district property or to local law enforcement. The designated employee must have their school ID and a letter from the superintendent while in transport of the items.
