Research Analysis

HB 2011 directs Service Oklahoma to promulgate rules and procedures to establish an option for a biennial registration for all vehicles other than manufactured homes, vehicles with a permanent non-expiring license plate and commercial vehicles registered pursuant to an installment plan.

The Senate amendment restores title.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 2011 allows for the option of biennial registration for vehicles. According to Service Oklahoma, should citizens opt for a biennial registration over an annual registration, there may be a potential increase of registration revenue of as much as \$34.8 million in FY24 followed by a revenue decrease of approximately \$17.7 million in FY25; these calculations were projected using the same rate that citizens have opted for an eight (8) year driver license over a four (4) year driver license. Service Oklahoma also anticipates programming costs associated with implementing biennial registration of \$93,500.00.

The Senate amendment accepts the restoration of the title, and makes no change in the fiscal impact analysis from the previous House Floor version of the measure.
