**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute for HB 2014, requires the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to seek waivers, and other federal approvals, that modify the state plan to allow Medicaid coverage for women for twelve months beginning on the last day of the pregnancy. The measure sets the automatic eligibility income at 205% of the most current federal poverty level.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The Oklahoma Health Care Authority (OHCA) is already doing this, but FPL was changed on this bill. OHCA expects the state share to increase by two hundred and fifty-five million dollars (\$2,550,000.00), with a total cost increase of seven million eight hundred thousand (\$7,800,000.00).
