Research Analysis

HB 2018 allows every applicant for a driver license or identification card to receive a caregiver identifier designation on the driver license or identification card that signifies that the holder of the card is a caregiver of an adult child who has developmental disabilities. The information is to notify law enforcement officers that special care may be needed when an officer comes in contact with an adult caregiver in the presence of an adult child with developmental disabilities.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 2018, as introduced, allows for driver license or identification card applicants to have the option of adding a caregiver identifier designation on his or her card. Per Service Oklahoma, this measure has an estimated cost of \$50,000 - \$100,000 related to programming changes needed to allow Service Oklahoma to change a card appearance for distribution. No recurring costs would result as Service Oklahoma is already paying for ongoing maintenance related to driver licensing.
