**Research Analysis**

HB 2022, as introduced, extends health benefit coverage to the dependents of school employees and CareerTech employees. A dependent could be a spouse if the spouse does not have subsidized coverage available from another source, an unmarried child under the age of 18, or an unmarried child under the age of 26 who is financially dependent upon the school employee. The employee would receive an additional \$154.90 monthly in their flexible benefit allowance to purchase the coverage for their dependent.
