**Research Analysis**

HB2024 requires a notary public to maintain an absentee ballot affidavit log that must include name and address of the voter and date, time, and location of the notarization. A notary public who is authorized to notarize more than 20 ballots for a single election must submit their log to the secretary of the county election board. The log will be public record and maintained by the secretary of the county election board. If a notary public who is required to submit a log fails to do so, they shall have their notary public appointment revoked for eight years by the Secretary of State. If the violation is intentional then they will be guilty of a misdemeanor and fined up to \$500.00.
