**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute for HB 2041 allows a law enforcement officer who comes into contact with a person who has a misdemeanor warrant to issue a verbal warning about the existence of the warrant and advise the person to contact the clerk of the court to resolve the outstanding warrant. All verbal warnings must be documented by law enforcement on a department-issued warning ticket.
