**Research Analysis**

The PCS to HB 2054 modifies the crime of prostitution to include knowingly offering to pay a fee to another person for the purpose of engaging in sexual conduct. The measure makes it unlawful for any person who pays a fee for a sexual encounter to publish a review of that sexual encounter or to publish a review of the pubic area, buttocks, or breasts experienced in the sexual encounter on a website that facilitates, encourages, offers, solicits or promotes sexual conduct with another for a fee. The crime is a felony punishable by not less than 3 years to life imprisonment, a fine of up to \$20,000 or both fine and imprisonment. If the victim of the offense is under 18 years of age, the punishment rises to not less than 9 years to life imprisonment a fine of up to \$25,000 or both fine and imprisonment. Upon a second or subsequent conviction, the person is required to register pursuant to the Oklahoma Sex Offender Registration Act.
