**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute for HB 2061 provides \$5,000,000 to the County Sheriff Public Safety Grant Revolving Fund from money remaining in the General Revenue Fund for the purpose of performing the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority, and to provide assistance to local law enforcement personnel.

**Fiscal Analysis**

In its current form, HB 2061 allocates five million dollars to the County Sheriff Public Safety Grant Revolving Fund from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority Revolving Fund (OMMA Revolving Fund) to assist local law enforcement in providing duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority. The OMMA Revolving Fund is a revolving fund collecting agency fines and fees as well as tax revenue on medical marijuana, that only sends surplus collections to the general revenue fund. As this fund is not a general revenue fund, nor a guaranteed source of general revenue, there is no fiscal impact to the state budget.
