Research Analysis

The senate amendments to HB2062 restores the title. As amended, the measure extends the motor fuel tax remittance discount for eligible purchasers until July, 1 2029. Currently, the discount is 1.6 percent for gasoline and 1.9 percent for diesel until July, 1, 2024.

Fiscal Analysis

As introduced, HB2062 extends a sunset provision, maintaining the current status quo related to such collections. For this reason, HB2062 is not expected to impact state revenues or state appropriations. The Senate amendment restores the title and enacting clause.
