Research Analysis

The committee substitute for HB 2065, establishes the "Pediatric Cancer Research and Resources Revolving Fund for the purpose of providing grants to entities engaging in research related to pediatric cancer, and to entities assisting families confronted with financial challenges associated with pediatric cancer treatment. The measure requires the State Department of Health to establish eligibility and application requirements for the awarding of grants, and prohibits award grants in excess of the balance of the Fund.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure creates the Pediatric Cancer Research & Resources Revolving Fund for the State Department of Health that will consist all monies for deposit to the fund by law and any public donations for proving grants to research pediatric cancer and to assists families confronted with financial challenges associated pediatric cancer treatment. The measure limits grants from the program to the amount of unencumbered monies in the Revolving Fund. The measure does not appropriate monies to the revolving fund; therefore, the HB 2065 has no direct fiscal impact on the state budget.
