The CS to HB 2130 provides convicted of driving under the influence of alcohol or other intoxicating substance and the offense causes the death of a parent or parents of a child, the sentencing court is to order the defendant to pay restitution in the form of child support for each child until the child reaches the age of 18 or when the child has graduated high school.
