Research Analysis

HB 2141, as introduced, adds facialists and demonstrators to the professions that are regulated by the Cosmetology and Barbering Act and requires salon suites and mini-salons to obtain an establishment license for each individual room. The measure increases the cosmetology and barber school licensing fee from \$400 to \$450 and the renewal fee from \$125 to \$150. Other board established fees are also increased by \$15 from the current amount, with the exception of the notary fee.

As introduced, HB2141 modifies definitions, penalties and licensure fees related to the Oklahoma Cosmetology and Barbering act. This measure does not mandate any action to any state appropriated agency, and is not expected to impact state revenues or state appropriations.
