The proposed substitute for HB 2163 gives licensure reimbursement eligibility to clinical psychology interns and postdoctoral fellows. The fellows and interns must be actively receiving board-approved supervision from a licensed psychologist who reviews and records the fellow or intern's work on a weekly basis.

HB2163 in its current form provides for licensure reimbursement for eligible clinical psychology interns and postdoctoral fellows. As this measure does not mandate any action to any appropriated state agency, it is not expected to impact state revenues or state appropriations.
