Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute for HB 2165 authorizes cities and towns to enact and municipal police officers to enforce ordinances prohibiting and penalizing underage tobacco, nicotine, or vapor usage. A fine for this will not exceed \$50 for a first offense or \$100 for subsequent offenses and the violator must attend an education program or class or a court-determined alternative program. The court may make referrals and may require other community service, services, and additional programs or classes for the violator.
