Research Analysis

HB 2180, as introduced, requires a student enrolled in a virtual charter school alternative education program and who attends a full abbreviated day to be counted in full attendance for purposes of computing the average daily attendance and average daily membership.

Further, if a student attending a virtual charter alternative education program is reported for truancy twice in the same year, the measure allows the school to seek a waiver on the student's behalf allowing the student to continue attending the school. Current law prohibits a student from re-enrolling in the same school after two truancy violations in one year.
