Research Analysis

The CS to HB 2186 makes it unlawful for a person to engage in an adult cabaret performance which is harmful to minors or to organize or authorize the viewing of an adult cabaret performance which is harmful to minors on public property or in a location where the adult cabaret performance could be viewed by a minor. Violations are a felony punishable by imprisonment with the Department of Corrections for not less than 30 days nor more than 2 years, a fine of not less than \$500 nor more than \$20,000 or both fine and imprisonment. Persons who organize or authorize such an event on public property may also be charged with a crime. Violation is a misdemeanor, punishable by up to 1 year in the county jail, a fine of not less than \$500 nor more than \$1,000 or both fine and imprisonment.

CHANGES MADE IN THE FLOOR SUBSTITUTE:

Modifies the definitions used in the section. The measure provides that it is unlawful to engage in an adult performance in a location other than a private adult setting. Modifies the definition of drag performer to include mannerisms associated with a sex other than the one assigned to the person at birth. Modifies the definition of minor to mean an unmarried person under 18 years of age.
