Research Analysis

The CS to HB 2228 prohibits the operation of a motor vehicle while holding or using a handheld cellular telephone when the vehicle is in motion. The measure prohibits the confiscation of a cellular telephone to determines a violation without consent of the person. The measure limits the fine amount to \$5 and court costs and fees to not more than \$95 and directs the apportionment of the \$95.

Officials from the Administrative Office of the Courts performed the following analysis on the crime code associated with this measure (crime code IN7) using the Oklahoma Court Information System (OCIS) database which collects data from 13 counties:

Data for the remaining 64 counties is retained by a third party vendor (KellPro), however the courts have found that impact from KellPro counties is roughly equivalent to that of the OCIS counties. As such, by doubling the above OCIS impacts that have been outlined, statewide impact is estimated to be as follows:
