Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute for HB 2242 requires public utilities and municipally-owned utility providers to waive the initial credit and deposit requirements for victims of domestic violence. A victim seeking such waiver must have a certification letter proving they are a victim of domestic violence. The criteria for such letter is listed in the measure. It expires after 90 days. The PCS adds an emergency.
