**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute for HB 2260 requires a school superintendent who is recommending the termination of a teacher for the following reasons to forward their recommendation to the State Board of Education:

- A civil settlement involving sexual abuse or sexual exploitation; or
- An agreement between the school and teacher to avoid civil litigation for actions involving sexual abuse or sexual exploitation.
