**Fiscal Analysis**

The Senate amendment to HB 2291 designates the Lt. Gen. Thomas P. Stafford Memorial Interchange in Custer County. Title 69 O.S. § 1600 provides that the costs associated with signage related to the naming of highways and bridges is to be paid by the group sponsoring or requesting the sign, except in instances of naming a highway or bridge to honor members of the United States Armed Forces, Oklahoma Highway Patrol, peace officers, and first responders who were killed in the performance of their duties.
