Research Analysis

The PCS1 to HB 2343 modifies the punishment for maintaining or operating any house or structure with the intent of committing an act of prostitution, transporting a person to a house of prostitution, or knowingly accepting any money from a prostitute or from the proceeds of any woman engaged in prostitution by removing the ability to sentence the violator to county jail or to fine the person. The measure also removes the ability to enhance the punishment if committed within 1,000 feet of a school.

The measure repeals the following sections of law:

[Title 21, Section 1192](#) relating to Penalty for Spreading Infectious Diseases;
[Title 21, Section 1192.1](#) relating to Penalty for Knowingly Intending to Transfer Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV); and
[Title 21, Section 1199](#) relating to Penalty for Exposing Oneself or Another With Contagious Disease in Public Place.
