**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute for HB2360 requires telecommunications providers applying for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to attest that they will comply with all applicable state and federal laws, and any rules and orders from the Corporation Commission. The measure also requires the telecommunications provider, instead of the Corporation Commission, to publish the required notice of application in a newspaper. Further, the applicant must provide notice of application to any cities and towns registered to receive such notices.
