Research Analysis

The committee substitute for HB2391 makes consumer litigation funding agreement subject to discovery. The measure requires a consumer or the consumer's attorney to disclose and deliver a copy of the agreement to all parties, courts and known entities involved in a civil action, administrative proceeding, claim or cause of action funded by an agreement. The consumer is required to provide the information without the need for a discovery request and has a continual obligation to provide updates when additional participants have been added to the funding agreement.
