**Research Analysis**

The floor amendment to HB 2416 adds a bridge dedication in Carter County to be designated as the "Shawn Skelly and Michael Shane Gilmore Memorial Bridge." The amendment also adds a highway dedication in Cleveland County to be designated as the "PO2 Casey Alan Lewis Memorial Highway."

**Fiscal Analysis**

The first floor amendment to HB 2416 designates two additional memorial highways and bridges located in Oklahoma. Title 69 O.S. § 1600 provides that the costs associated with signage related to the naming of highways and bridges is to be paid by the group sponsoring or requesting the sign, except in instances of naming a highway or bridge to honor members of the United States Armed Forces, Oklahoma Highway Patrol, peace officers, and first responders who were killed in the performance of their duties.

The Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT) currently estimates a cost of \$1,300 per location, with one sign needed at each end of the designated highway or bridge.
