Fiscal Analysis

This measure would increase juror's fees from \$20 to \$75 for each day's attendance before any court of record. The following cost analysis has been provided by the Administrative Office of the Courts:

Current Juror reimbursement rate (per day):	\$20
Current annual cost (avg over 5 years):	\$1,284,587
Estimated annual impact to the SJF if juror costs are raised to	\$4,239,138
\$75 per day:	
Cost increase to SJF:	\$2,954,551

Their analysis provides that, based on the \$1,284,487 current 5 year average annual cost of juror reimbursement, HB2430 would cost the State Judicial Fund an estimated \$4,239,138 per year, an increase of \$2,954,551 from the current 5 year average annual cost.
