## **Research Analysis**

The conference committee substitute for HB 2459 modifies personnel definitions according to the <u>Filmed in Oklahoma Act of 2021</u> and authorizes the Department of Commerce to approve:

- an incentive of five percent of the qualified production expenditure amount for projects that filmed on location at least 25 percent of the time;
- an incentive of two percent of the qualified production expenditure amount for the post production costs of music production, recording, composition, or licensing of Oklahoma music;
- a maximum incentive increase, excluding above-the line-personnel, of 30 percent;
- an incentive of 20 percent for nonresident crew; and
- an incentive of two percent of the qualified production expenditure amount for projects that film at least 25% of principal photography days in a municipality with a population of 25,000 or less.

The measure also requires projects that receive incentives to display a Department of Commerceapproved logo in the credits for at least five seconds.
