## **Research Analysis**

The CS to HB 2608 modifies the definition of "local law enforcement authority" within the Oklahoma Sex Offender Registration Act to include the police or law enforcement officers of any federally recognized Indian nation or tribe in Oklahoma. This will require persons subject to registration to report to such law enforcement if they reside or stay within the jurisdictional boundaries of the Indian nation or tribe.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

This measure would require persons subject to sex offender registration to report to law enforcement if they reside or stay within the jurisdictional boundaries of a federally recognized Indian nation or tribe in Oklahoma.
