Research Analysis

The CS to HB 2644 prohibits any person, property owner, tenant, employer, or business entity from establish or enforce any policy or rule that prohibits any person or employee from transporting, carrying, or storing firearms or ammunition in a locked motor vehicle on any property set aside for any motor vehicle, or a motor vehicle owned, leased, or rented by the person or employee to conduct business for the business entity. The measure allows an individual to bring a civil action against a person or entity which prohibits a person from transporting or storing firearms in a locked motor vehicle.
