Research Analysis

HB 2641 clarifies the exemption provided for the possession of firearms on public property. The measure adds "street, plaza, sidewalk, and alley" to the list of places a governmental entity may designate by statute, ordinance, resolution, policy or use as an area where a firearm may be carried. The measure allows a person to openly carry on the property of a nonprofit entity with permission from the public trust or nonprofit entity.
