Research Analysis

The Senate amendments to HB 2684 modifies the name of the section of law as the Bernardo-Mills Law. The measure provides that a person is to be guilty of the offense of endangerment of an emergency worker for violations of this provision. The measure creates a penalty for endangerment of an emergency worker punishable by a fine of \$1,000 for a first offense and \$2,500 for a second offense. The measure creates a penalty for aggravated endangerment of an emergency worker when the offense results in the injury or death of an emergency worker. The penalty is a fine of \$5,000 if the offense resulted in injury and \$10,000 if the offense resulted in the death of an emergency worker.
